Hike, mountain bike or horseback ride this state park's backcountry trails for spectacular views of the Great Salt Lake. Spend a star-filled night in one of several primitive campsites. Gaze at free-ranging bison, mule deer, bighorn sheep, pronghorn (antelope), or dozens of species of waterfowl and upland birds.

Causey Reservoir - recreation

This 142-acre alpine reservoir restricts motorized boats, making it an idyllic location for kayaks, canoes, and stand-up paddleboards. It's 5,700' elevation makes for brisk swimming, but also makes it ideal for healthy populations of trout and Kokanee salmon, which run up Causey's tributaries in a brilliant display of red every September.

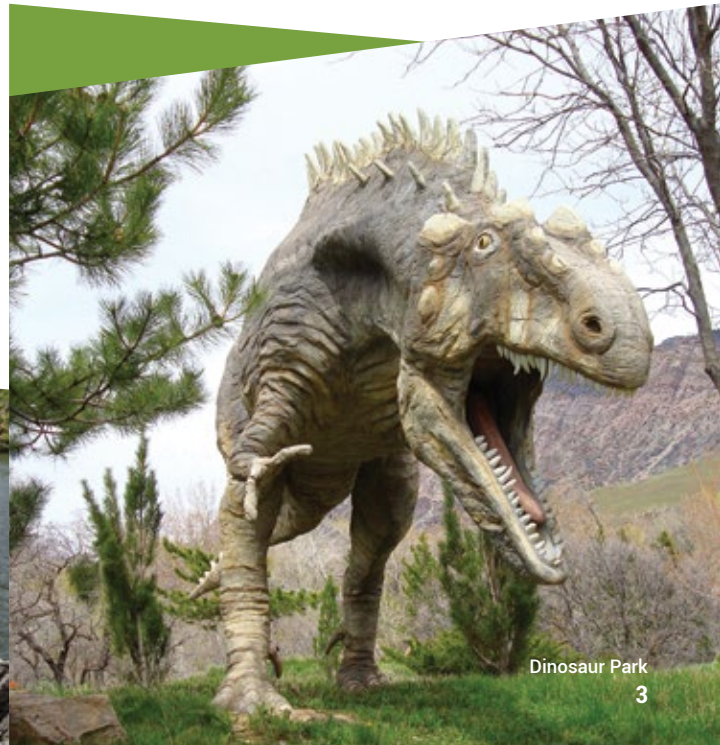

A museum provides hands-on experiences with fossil discovery and several full-size dinosaur skeletons.

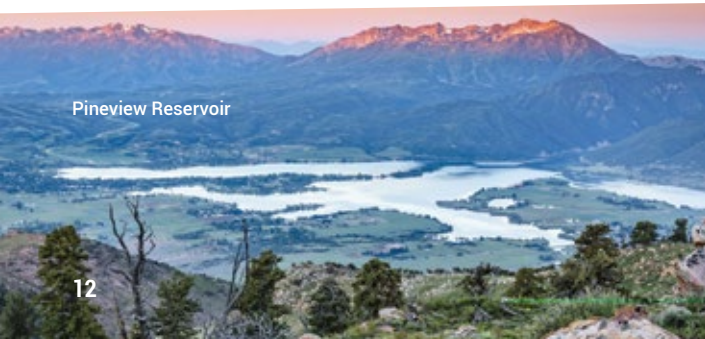

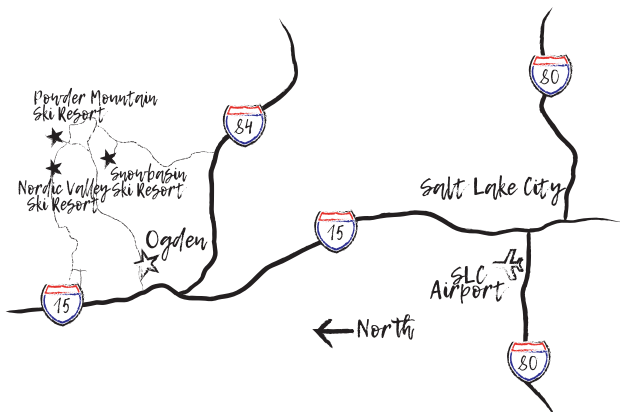
