A BIT ABOUT OUR DNA

Once home to ancient Fremont Indians, on the border between the later Northern Paiute and Southern Shoshone tribes, the first Anglo settlement here came when mountain men established Fort Benaventura near the confluence of the Ogden and Weber Rivers to trade with both tribes while trapping the abundant rivers and nearby valleys, making Ogden the oldest non-native settlement in Utah.

Shortly thereafter, Brigham Young purchased the fort and established a Mormon farming settlement that lasted for a couple of decades before the world changed with the completion of the Transcontinental Railroad in 1869.

Ogden became the "Junction City" between the Union and Central Pacific Railroads and for a century it was said, "You can't go anywhere without coming to Ogden."

We welcomed Presidents and captains of industry alongside gamblers and purveyors of vice. Opulent hotels with nearby brothels, the finest cuisine paired with the best bootlegged liquor, the latest fashion sold on the street with opium dens lurking in basements below.

We're not exactly all that anymore, but Ogden is and always has been the most gritty, multi-cultural, diverse, welcoming, eclectic city in Utah.

It's where we come from. It's who we are.
